

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Township of Richfield for fire protection for the period from March 1, 1999 through February 29, 2000, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide fire protection to the residents of the Township of Richfield at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO AND THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD, OHIO

Pursuant to R.C. 505.44, 505.443 and 9.60 et seq. together with the exercise of the powers set forth in the Charter and the Constitution, this Agreement is signed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1999 by and between the Village of Richfield, Ohio referred to as the Village, and the Township of Richfield, Ohio, referred to as the Township.

The parties agree as follows:

1. In order to provide fire protection and prevention, and rescue squad service, the Village will answer, service and aid in (1) controlling fires, (2) fire prevention and inspection, (3) all emergency calls, (4) all non-emergency calls and squad services which originate in Richfield Township for a period beginning March 1, 1999 and continuing to February 29, 2000, both inclusive, or until this Agreement is rescinded by resolution of either party and upon a written 90-day notice.
2. The Township agrees to pay the Village therefor the sum of Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$213,000.00) payable in four equal quarterly installments due on the 1st day of March, June, September and December 1999.
3. After the close of the contract, the Village shall submit to the Township a schedule of the fire and rescue squad calls answered in Richfield Township.
4. The Township agrees to hold the members of the Village Fire and Rescue Squad individually harmless from any and all liability that may arise in going to or from or attending a fire or rescue call or in failing to do so.
5. The term of this contract shall be from March 1, 1999 to and including February 29, 2000.
6. Semiannually, the Village will pay to the Township EMS billings and payments that the Village has received from insurance companies for services for Township residents for the period March 1, 1999 to February 29, 2000.
7. This contract is entered into pursuant to Resolution No. 19-1999 of the Village of Richfield and Resolution No. 7-1999 of the Township of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio.
