

ORDINANCE NO. 24-1999

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$11,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PARTS AND LABOR TO REPLACE THE TRANSFER SWITCH FOR THE VILLAGE'S BACK-UP POWER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there be, and the same hereby is, appropriated:

From the Capital Improvement Fund the sum of \$11,000.00 for the purpose of this project.

SECTION 2. That the purpose of the foregoing appropriation is to provide for parts and labor to replace the transfer switch for the Village's back-up power system.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for the safety of Village residents; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
