

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR SALE TO THE VILLAGE OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for sale to the Village of an emergency medical vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief recommends acceptance of the bid of Horton Emergency Vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Horton Emergency Vehicles as set forth in its bid of December 17, 1997, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference, for sale to the Village of an emergency medical vehicle be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$126,248.00 from the Fire Truck, etc. Fund for purchase of the emergency medical vehicle.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide essential lifesaving equipment; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



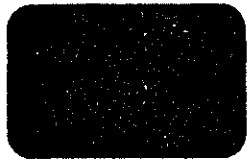

Gentlemen,

We hereby propose and agree to furnish to you the following Emergency Medical Vehicle conversion upon your acceptance of this proposal:

One (1) 1998 Freightliner chassis and a Horton 603 Type I Series all aluminum Emergency Medical Vehicle Conversion delivered in accordance with the enclosed specifications, with noted exceptions, which we hereby make part of our proposal, complete and delivered for the sum of \$126,248.00 due on delivery.

Due to the scarce availability of component parts, and in spite of spiralling costs, we will stand behind our contract price. Therefore, we do require full payment at the time of delivery.

The new Emergency Medical Vehicle shall be delivered approximately 180 days after receipt of contract, barring any delays due to strikes, availability of component parts, or Acts of God. Unless accepted within (30) days from date, the right to withdraw this proposal is reserved.
