

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 941.05 OF THE STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE PERTAINING TO RECYCLING OF YARD WASTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 941.05(b) of the Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code be amended to read as follows:

“941.05 RECYCLING OF CERTAIN MATERIALS.

(a) \* \* \*

(b) Yard Waste. Residents are encouraged to compost tree trimmings, grass clippings and leaves on their own premises. The Village will provide brush chipping on a year-round basis, and leaf collection during the fall season.

(c) \* \* \*”

SECTION 2. That Section 941.05(b) as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to become effective for the spring collection season; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
