

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF EXCESS POLICE EQUIPMENT TO BROXTON, GEORGIA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Police Chief be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to donate excess police equipment, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference, to the Police Department of Broxton, Georgia.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to assist a sister Police Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
