

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF A VILLAGE HUMAN RESOURCES COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY HUMAN RESOURCE PROGRAM WHICH WOULD RECOMMEND PUBLIC POLICIES ENCOMPASSING THE ASSISTANCE TO CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, numerous citizens of the Village of Richfield have expressed an interest in formation of a Human Resources Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the Village of Richfield wishes to have Council form a Human Resources Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Richfield wishes to form a Human Resources Commission in order to create and propose activities for Richfield citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That a Commission consisting of five (5) members, one chosen from within Council to serve a one year term and four (4) Village residents chosen by the Mayor and approved by Council to serve staggered terms so that they will initially expire on December 31, 1998, one term to expire on December 31, 1999, one term to expire December 31, 2000 and one term to expire on December 31, 2001. Thereafter the terms will be for four (4) years.
- SECTION 2. The Commission shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Mayor and Council to recommend creation of programs and services to benefit the citizens of the Village of Richfield. Rules and regulations for the programs and policies for the administration of the programs shall be developed by the Mayor and Council.
- SECTION 3. Each Commission member, except the Council member, shall be reimbursed for expenses in an amount not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each regularly scheduled meeting attended.
- SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to implement a human resources program at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect

immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
