

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE LIFEPAK 12 DEFIBRILLATOR/MONITORS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has determined that it is in need of two Lifepak 12 defib/monitors; and

WHEREAS, during the month of March, these monitors are available from Physio-Control Corporation with trade-in at a discount; and

WHEREAS, the offer for purchase of these defib/monitors from Physio-Control is \$19,546.00 provided that the equipment is purchased before March 30, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief believes that this is a fair price and the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to purchase two (2) Lifepak 12 defib/monitors with discount and trade-in for a total of \$19,546.00 on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be take advantage of the discounts by March 30, 1998; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
