

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION AS DULY SERVED AND INDICATING SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE PROPOSED ANNEXED TERRITORY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by letter dated April 3, 1998, Curtis Alberti, Esq., agent for Petitioners to annex approximately 8.8540 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield notified the Village of Richfield that the Petition was filed with the Summit County Council at their meeting of March 26, 1998; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 709.01, a hearing has been scheduled for Monday, July 6, 1998; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 709.031, this Council wishes to acknowledge receipt of the Petition and to indicate the services to be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the Petition for Annexation of 8.8540 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, which Petition was accepted for filing by the Summit Council at their meeting of March 26, 1998.

SECTION 2. This Council hereby indicates that all Village services, including, but not limited to, police, fire, service and garbage will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby declares its intent to accept dedication of the proposed annexation when presented pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reasons to be effective by the July 6, 1998 hearing before the Summit County Council; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
