A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF INTERNATIONAL SAFETY INSTRUMENTS, INC. FOR SALE TO THE VILLAGE OF A THERMAL IMAGER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Director received a bid on August 26, 1998 for sale to the Village of a thermal imager from International Safety Instruments, Inc. for sale of an ISI Vision 3 Thermal Imager in the amount of \$15,700.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of International Safety Instruments, Inc. for sale to the Village of an ISI Vision 3 Thermal Imager in the amount of \$15,700.00, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to insure the safety of the personnel of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
