

**A RESOLUTION TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR
OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE
OF OHIO DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1998**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: To provide for other expenditures of the said Village of Richfield during the year ending December 31, 1998, the following sums be, and they hereby are, set aside and appropriated as follows:
