

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF FORESTRIDGE SUBDIVISION PHASES I, II AND III AND RELEASING PERFORMANCE AND MAINTENANCE BONDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the dedication for public purposes of Forestridge Subdivision Phases I, II and III be, and the same hereby are, accepted and the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to release the performance and maintenance bonds for these phases.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide Village maintenance as promptly as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
