

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF LEAF MULCH AND WOOD CHIPS TO RICHFIELD LANDSCAPE CONTRACTORS, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, leaf mulch and wood chips from throughout the Village are temporarily being stored on a property on Brecksville Road; and

WHEREAS, the Village will save money by having Richfield Landscape Contractors, Inc. remove this mulch and wood chips at no expense to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Richfield Landscape Contractors, Inc. be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to remove leaf mulch and wood chips from properties throughout the Village which are currently being stored on Brecksville Road at no cost to the Village.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the removal of the leaf mulch and wood chips due to the onset of the winter season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
