

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF APPORTIONMENT OF THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUND AND THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVENUE ASSISTANCE FUND OF SUMMIT COUNTY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1999

WHEREAS, the recommended alternative method of apportionment has been reviewed by the Summit County Budget Commission and that Commission has submitted that alternative method of apportionment to this Council of the Village of Richfield and has requested that this Council of the Village of Richfield consider and determine whether it wishes to approve that method, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5747.53 of the Revised Code which provides for an alternative method of apportioning the undivided Local Government Fund of the County and Section 5747.63 of the Revised Code which provides for an alternative method of apportioning the undivided Local Government Revenue Assistance Fund of the County, if that alternative method shall have first been approved by the County Council, the Council of the City of Akron, and a majority of the boards of township trustees and legislative authorities of the other municipal corporations located wholly or partially in the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council of the Village of Richfield, having considered the alternative method presented by the Budget Commission, hereby finds, determines and declares that it is appropriate to approve that method pursuant to Sections 5747.53 and 5747.63 of the Revised Code and to evidence its approval by the adoption of this legislation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

- SECTION 1. The alternative method of apportionment and the 1999 apportionment of the undivided Local Government Fund and the undivided Local Government Revenue Assistance Fund of the County of Summit set forth in the form attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference herein is hereby approved upon the terms, conditions and for the year indicated in such attached alternative method of apportionment.
- SECTION 2. The Clerk of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately forward a copy of this legislation to the County Auditor as Secretary of the County Budget Commission.
- SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council of the Village of Richfield concerning and relating to the enactment of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council of the Village of Richfield, and that all deliberations of this Council of the Village of Richfield and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 4. In accordance with Sections 5747.53 and 5747.63 of the Revised Code, this legislation shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and need not be published.
