

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF CIGNA HEALTH CARE FOR HEALTH INSURANCE AND MUTUAL OF OMAHA COMPANIES FOR LIFE INSURANCE AND ACCIDENTAL DEATH AND DISMEMBERMENT FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

- Section 1. That the bids of Cigna Health Care for health insurance and Mutual of Omaha Companies for life insurance and accidental death and dismemberment in the total amount of \$177,688.32 be, and the same hereby are, accepted.
- Section 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide insurance coverage for Village employees; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
