

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A RADIO FOR THE SAFETY FORCES ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS

WHEREAS, the Fire Department is in immediate need of a replacement radio due to a lightning strike; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to purchase a radio for the safety forces on an emergency basis in an amount currently estimated not to exceed \$7,640.00.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the continued operation of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
