

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF KELCORP CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR REPAIR OF THE HUMPHREY ROAD CULVERT ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS

WHEREAS, the repair of the Humphrey Road storm sewer culvert is immediately necessary prior to the onset of the winter season; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Kelcorp Construction Co. in the amount of \$22,470.00 for repair of the Humphrey Road storm sewer culvert be, and the same hereby is, accepted on an emergency basis.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to have the work performed before the onset of the winter season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

NOTE: This is a prevailing wage project.



INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. INTRODUCTORY
Proposals to be entitled to consideration, must be made in accordance with the following instructions.
2. DOCUMENTS
 - (A) Drawings page 1 of 1 with specifications.
 - (B) Instructions to bidders
 - (C) Minimum wage scale
3. WRITTEN AND ORAL EXPLANATIONS
Should a bidder find discrepancies in, or omissions from the drawings and specifications, or should be in doubt as to their meanings, he shall at once notify the engineer, who shall send a written instruction to all bidders.
4. ADDENDA
Addenda issued during time of bidding shall be covered in the proposal, and in closing a contract became a part thereof.
5. SITE VISITATION
Bidders shall, before submitting their proposals, visit the site and thoroughly familiarize themselves with the scope of the work in connection therewith, and the conditions under which it will have to be executed. Lack of such knowledge will not be acceptable as valid excuse for granting extra compensation, or failure, neglect or refusal to perform any or all of the work in this contract.
6. PROPOSALS
 - A. Preparation. Proposals shall be made upon forms furnished by the architect. Each signature shall be clearly and legibly written in longhand. No oral, telegraphic or telephone proposals or modifications shall be considered.

- B. Signatures. Proposals shall be signed with the full name of each and every person having interest therein; in case of partnerships, the full name of each individual partner shall be given; in the case of corporations, the corporate name shall be signed by one of its officers duly authorized to do so. If there is more than one page of the proposal, each page shall be signed.
- C. Delivery. Proposals shall be enclosed in envelopes, endorsed with the name of the bidder of the work bid upon, sealed and delivered to the office of the service director of the Village of Richfield, by the date and time specified by the owner.
- D. Rejection. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all parts of and all bids.
7. BOND AND INSURANCE
Successful bidders shall be asked to submit a 100% performance bond and necessary contractor's liability insurance before signing the contract.
8. PRICE GUARANTEE
All bid prices shall be guaranteed by the contractor for six months from the date of the proposal.
9. DATE OF WORK
The work of this proposal is estimated to commence during July, 1996.
10. BID BOND
Proposals shall be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in the amount of 10% of bid.
11. GUARANTEE BOND
After completion of work, contractor shall furnish a one year maintenance bond.
12. BASE BID
Shall be for all work as described on the plan sheets and additional work in paragraph 14 of the instructions to bidders.
13. ALTERNATE "A" BID
None
14. Additional work not shown on plans.
A. Traffic control shall be provided pursuant to ODOT construction traffic control manual.
15. All payment requests shall be on AIA forms furnished by contractor and accompanied by labor/material affidavit.
16. Estimated project cost \$ 18,000.
