A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a pick-up truck for the Service Department in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in his office.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide a needed piece of equipment for the Service Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
