A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF AMERICAN TRADESMAN, INC. FOR THE HUMPHREY ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received on June 19, 1996 for the Humphrey Road culvert replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has recommended the acceptance of the bid of American Tradesman, Inc. in the amount of \$19,615.31 as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of American Tradesman, Inc. in the amount of \$19,615.31 for the Humphrey Road culvert replacement, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for road safety, wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
