

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH APPRAISAL, CONSULTING, RESEARCH AND TRAINING, INC. (ACRT) FOR PROFESSIONAL FORESTRY CONSULTING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE TREE AND LANDSCAPING PLANS OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with ACRT for professional forestry consulting services in connection with the Tree and Landscaping Plans of the Village of Richfield. Said agreement will be in effect for one (1) year, for a maximum of 100 hours at a rate not to exceed \$30.00 per hour.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary for this agreement to take effect as soon as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
