

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF COE, INC. FOR RESURFACING OF CONGRESS PARKWAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for the resurfacing of Congress Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of COE, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of COE, Inc. came to the amount of \$111,410 being the lowest and best bid being the same is hereby is accepted for the resurfacing of Congress Parkway.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary be done in the summer building season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
