A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF WARREN FIRE EQUIPMENT, INC.
FOR SALE OF A FIRE TRUCK TO THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for sale of a fire truck to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended acceptance of the bid of Warren Fire Equipment, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Warren Fire Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$202,606.00 plus additional equipment of \$15,486.00 for a total bid of \$218,092.00, being the lowest and best bid, be and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated an additional amount as follows: from the Capital Improvement Fund

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to protect the lives of Village residents; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
