

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF MONEY FOR SCHOOL FLASHING LIGHTS ON WEST STREETSBORO ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Richfield to install school flashing lights on West Streetsboro Road in front of the Richfield Elementary School in an amount not to exceed \$3,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$3,500 for the purpose of purchasing school flashing lights on West Streetsboro Road in front of the Richfield Elementary School.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the installation of traffic lights is immediately necessary for school safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
