

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) NEW POLICE CRUISERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for sale to the Village of three (3) new Police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Goddard Ford in the amount of \$16,328.29 per cruiser is the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Goddard Ford for sale to the Village of three (3) new Police cruisers in the amount of \$16,328.29 per cruiser, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide effective Police service; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
