



licensed contractor who will perform the tap, and shall require a payment in accordance with the five factor formula contained in Exhibits "A" and "B-2" of Ordinance 5-1991 using an average of the assessments in Sewer Districts One, Two and Three, giving a credit of up to \$3,500 for those residents who must bore under either Brush or Humphrey Roads, if necessary.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to establish tap-in conditions for property owners who wish to build on Brush and Humphrey Roads; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
