

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR TRENCHING FOR ELECTRICAL PURPOSES ALONG BRECKSVILLE ROAD NORTH OF THE OHIO TURNPIKE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to advertise for bids for trenching for electrical purposes along Brecksville Road north of the Ohio Turnpike, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village Engineer now on file with such Director of Public Service.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for trenching for electrical purposes with the lowest and best bidder after advertising and subject to approval of the bid by Council pursuant to Ordinance No. 25-1994 according to law.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason that the trenching for electrical purposes is urgently needed and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
