

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1995

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. To provide for other expenditures of the said Village of Richfield during the year ending December 31, 1995, the following sums be, and they hereby are, set aside and appropriated as follows:

SECTION 2. That there be appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund:

SECTION 3. That there be appropriated from the Sanitary Sewer Fund:

A.	Engineering (Sewer Line Extension)	\$65,056.00

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees or subcommittees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village for payments for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board of officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with the law or Ordinance.

SECTION 6. In accordance with Section 4.12 of the Charter of the Village of Richfield, this Resolution No. 100-1995 shall take effect and be in force upon the approval of the Mayor.
