

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE WEST STREETSBORO ROAD PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Village Administration and Council extensively discussed the construction of a pedestrian crosswalk crossing West Streetsboro Road from Town Hall to Humphrey Road; and

WHEREAS, those discussions resulted in final plans and specifications prepared by the Village Engineer and approved by Village Council at its December 15, 2021 Work Session, currently on file with the Director of Public Service; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Director of Public Service have recommended advertisement for bids for this project in accordance with the plans and specifications currently on file with the Director of Public Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Director of Public Service are hereby authorized and directed to solicit bids for the West Streetsboro Road Pedestrian Crosswalk Project in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village Engineer currently on file with the Director of Public Service.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to receive the bids, award the contract, and complete this project during the 2022 construction season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
