

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNS ANNOUNCING RICHFIELD'S SISTER CITY, WOLFACH, GERMANY, ON THE "WELCOME TO RICHFIELD" SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Mundialization Committee met on January 11, 1994; and

WHEREAS, one of the recommendations of the Mundialization Committee to Council is that signs announcing that Richfield has a sister city, Wolfach, Germany, be placed on the six "Welcome to Richfield" signs; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the placement of these signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to have signs announcing that the Village of Richfield has a sister city, Wolfach, Germany, made and that the Service Director be, and he further is, authorized and directed to have these signs placed on the six "Welcome to Richfield" signs at the entrance to the Village.

SECTION 2. That the design of the signs, including the size, lettering, type face, color and language, be formulated and approved by the Mundialization Committee, and that the signs as finally designed be reviewed and approved by the Planning & Zoning Commission and that all costs for the construction and installation be paid for by the Mundialization Committee.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
