

A Resolution to authorize the Director of Public Service to advertise, and for the Mayor and Director of Finance to accept Bids for the sale of a 1976 Chevrolet Rescue Equipment Truck and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has determined this equipment is no longer needed for the use in the Village of Richfield, which this Council finds should be sold to the highest and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the sale of this vehicle and the Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to sell to the highest and best bidder the surplus equipment.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety for the reason to eliminate surplus equipment; and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
