

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Finance Director to purchase a CRAFCO EZ POUR-100 Heavy Duty Diesel Fired Crack Sealer Machine through the Cooperative Purchasing Program of The Ohio Department of Transportation and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 51-1988, the Village of Richfield entered into the Cooperative Purchasing Program of The Ohio Department of Transportation of the State of Ohio and

WHEREAS, the Service Department has informed Council that the Village is in need of a new CRAFCO EZ Pour-100 Heavy Duty Diesel Fired Crack Sealer Machine and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program has determined that such a vehicle would be available from D.J.L. Material & Supply, Inc., P.O. Box 5293 2231 Short Hills Dr., Akron, Ohio 44333 at a cost of \$14,794.00 which the Service Director believes is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a new CRAFCO EZ Pour-100 Heavy Duty Diesel Fired Crack Sealer Machine from D.J.L. Material & Supply, Inc., P.O. Box 5293 2231 Short Hills Dr., Akron, Ohio 44333 through the Ohio of Transportation State Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the machine is immediately necessary for the functioning of the Service Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
