

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT ASSISTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Summit County Department of Community Development is the official entitlement Agency and direct liaison with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS: The Village of Richfield and the County of Summit have entered into an agreement of cooperation for the Community Development Block Grant Program, and

WHEREAS: The Summit County Department of Community Development is now accepting applications through the Community Development Block Grant Program, and

WHEREAS: The Application Deadline for Summit County is April 8, 1994.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to file an Application on behalf of the Village of Richfield with the County of Summit for funds for improvements for:

1. The Village of Richfield Recreation Building Handicap Access.
2. The Village of Richfield Historic Center of Town Revitalization Project.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason of application deadline and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
