

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR VARIOUS STREET IMPROVEMENTS OF VILLAGE STREETS AND FOR ADDITIONAL RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- SECTION 1:** The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for various street improvements of Village Roadway and for the seal coating of the service building garage parking lot.
- SECTION 2:** The agreements for (1) asphalt resurfacing, (2) seal coating, (3) pavement markings and (4) drainage headwall construction, and the parking lot shall be let in four separate agreements as set forth in the specifications.
- SECTION 3:** The plans and specifications for each separate resurfacing project, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are hereby approved.
- SECTION 4:** The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a separate agreement with the lowest and best bidder for each project after advertising according to law, subject to determination by Council of lowest and best bidder as defined in Ordinance No. 25-1994.
- SECTION 5:** This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason the various street improvements are needed for the proper roadways and, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
