

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN  
APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO TO  
THE SUMMIT COUNTY DISTRICT 8 INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE FOR  
STATE ISSUE 2 ASSISTANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS:** The Village of Richfield has received notification of the availability of funds for capital improvement projects pursuant to Chapter 164 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

**WHEREAS:** The Village of Richfield had committed local funds and investigated all other available sources of funding <sup>and</sup> had had plans and specifications prepared for the requested projects, and

**WHEREAS:** The Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee is now accepting applications for Issue 2 Program Year 9, LTIP Program Year 7 for funding requests through the State Infrastructure Bond Program and the Village of Richfield hereby requests funding approval, and

**WHEREAS:** The application deadline for District 8 is July 22, 1994.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,*** by the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor is authorized and directed to file an application on behalf of the Village of Richfield with the Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee for funds for Infrastructure for as many of the projects listed on attached "A".

**SECTION 2:** The Village of Richfield hereby agrees to abide by all rules and regulation of the Program with its funding requirements, and hereby commits to continual progress toward implementation of these improvement projects.

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason that the application deadline is imminent and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
