

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 923.01 (B) INCREASING THE RATE FOR BILLING AND COLLECTION SERVICES TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF CLEVELAND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Finance Director received a letter dated June 15, 1994 advising that the charge for billing and collection services by the City of Cleveland will be increased on a quarterly bases from \$3.43 per charge to \$3.69 per charge.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 923.01(b) of the Streets, Utilities and Public Services Code be amended to read as follows:

"923.01 RATES; METER SHARING; WATER USE PERMIT."

(a) ***

(b) Additional Assessment Charges for First 1,000 Cubic Feet. In addition to the foregoing charges made by the City of Cleveland, there shall be charged an assessment of four dollars and sixty-four cents (\$4.64) paid quarter-annually for the first 1,000 cubic feet or less of water used in any quarter, such charge to be used for the following:

1. Ninety-five cents (\$.95) for maintenance of the water system.
2. Three dollars and sixty-nine (\$3.69) for each quarter-year billing to be paid to the City of Cleveland for billing and collecting.
3. The foregoing charges less the three dollars and sixty-nine cents (\$3.69) billing and collection charge shall be paid quarter-annually to the Director of Finance of the Village.

(c) through (f) ***"

SECTION 2: The Section 923.01(b) as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason of increasing the for billing and collection services to be paid to the City of Cleveland and provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date approved by law.
