

ORDINANCE NO. 42-1994

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,793.00 FROM THE HERSCHEL HUNT DONATION FUND TO PAY FOR THE PREVIOUSLY CONSTRUCTED CONCESSION STAND AT THE RICHFIELD WOODS PLAYGROUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That there be, and there hereby is, appropriated from the Herschel Hunt Donation Fund the sum of \$4,793.00 for the purpose of paying for the previously constructed concession stand at the Richfield Woods playground.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the concession is immediately necessary for the summer season; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
