

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR A SURETY BOND IN CONNECTION WITH OBTAINING AN UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK BOND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village of Richfield to purchase a Surety Bond pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3737.91 in regards to obtaining an underground storage tank permit from the State of Ohio in relation to its underground storage tank; and

WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor has requested that Council grant authority to the Mayor and Finance Director to sign the Application for such a bond with the Ohio Casualty Insurance Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director of the Village of Richfield be, and they hereby are, authorized to sign the Application for Surety Bond referred to in the preamble of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the Surety Bond required by Ohio Revised Code Section 3737.91; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
