A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF THE FOREST
RIDGE SUBDIVISION PHASES II AND III AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Forest Ridge Subdivision Phases II and
III has been approved by the Village Engineer and Village Planning
Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the
Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the acceptance of dedication of the streets,
utilities and public way of the Forest Ridge Subdi-
vision Phases II and III be, and the same hereby
is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emer-
gency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public health, safety and welfare and
for the further reason that it is immediately
necessary so that the Village can commence snow
plowing during the winter season; wherefore, pro-
vided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote
of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or
appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon
its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise,
it shall take effect and be in force from and after
the earliest period allowed by law.
