

A RESOLUTION TO GRANT THE FINANCE DIRECTOR AUTHORITY TO CLOSE FISCAL YEAR 1994 AND MAKE NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Auditor has recommended the passage of this Resolution to grant authorization to the Finance Director to amend the Village's Certificate of Resources and Annual Appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the State Auditor has indicated that other communities have passed a similar type of resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and she hereby is, granted authority to close fiscal year 1994 books and records and to make necessary adjustments to the Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to give the Finance Director authority to take action before the end of the year; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
