

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 1993 POLICE CRUISERS THROUGH THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 50-1988, the Village of Richfield entered into the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has informed Council that the Village is in need of two (2) Police Cruisers; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program has determined that such a vehicle would be available from *32 Ford-Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103* at a cost of *\$11,872.00 each* or *\$23,744.00 total* which the Service Director believes is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase two (2) new 1993 Crown Victoria Police Cruisers from *32 Ford-Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103* at a cost of *\$11,872.00 each* or *\$23,744.00 total* through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' State Cooperative Purchasing Program.


SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the vehicles are immediately necessary for the functioning of the Police Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and

execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
