WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has compiled a list of surplus Village equipment which this Council find should be sold to the highest and best bidder, a copy of which list is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the sale of certain surplus Village equipment, and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to sell to the highest and best bidder or bidders the surplus equipment attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety for the reason to eliminate surplus equipment; and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY DISTRICT 8 INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE FOR STATE ISSUE 2 ASSISTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Village of Richfield has received notification of the availability of funds for capital improvement projects pursuant to Chapter 164 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS: The Village of Richfield has committed local funds and investigated all other available sources of funding and has had plans and specifications prepared for the requested projects (where applicable), and

WHEREAS: The Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee is now accepting applications for funding requests through the State Infrastructure Bond Program and the Village of Richfield hereby requests funding approval, and

WHEREAS: The application deadline for District 8 is ~~October 13, 1992~~ ^{July 20, 1993}

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is authorized and directed to file an application on behalf of the Village of Richfield with the Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee for funds for ~~Brecksville Road water line Phase IV; Engineering - Traffic signal replacement and intersection improvement - Brecksville and State Route 303; Brecksville Road resurfacing from Everett Road north to I-77; Brecksville Road (SR 21) curbs, gutters and storm drains replacement - engineering - Phase I; Sawbridge Drive, Scanwood Drive, and Burrwood Drive resurfacing.~~

SECTION 2: The Village of Richfield hereby agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations of the program with its funding requirements, and hereby commits to continual progress toward implementation of these improvement projects.


