

A Supplemental Resolution to make additional appropriations for current expenses of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, during the year ending December 31, 1993 and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield desires to provide a Supplemental Appropriation Resolution for the refurbishing of the 1980 Chevy Dump Truck used by the Service Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

SECTION 1: To provide for additional expenses of the Village of Richfield during the year ending December 31, 1993 the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:

SECTION 2: That there be appropriated from the Income Tax Fund:

Street Maintenance and Repair Fund \$ 23,000.00


SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and for the further reason of additional appropriations for current Village expenses and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
