

ORDINANCE 48-1992

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON, OHIO, FOR THE FURNISHING OF PROSECUTORIAL SERVICES IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF AKRON AND DELCARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, from time to time certain legal matters which concern the Village of Richfield are heard and determined in the Municipal Court of Akron, Ohio and the services of a Prosecutor are required, and

WHEREAS, the services of the office of the Prosecutor of the City of Akron are need and would be in the best interest of this Village.


Now Therefore Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- SECTION 1:** The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Akron, Ohio, of certain prosecutorial services, commencing July 1, 1992.
- SECTION 2:** The form of the agreement, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is hereby approved.
- SECTION 3:** The Director of Finance is authorized to pay for such services by drawing on the appropriate account of this Village and paying the same to the City of Akron, Ohio.
- SECTION 4:** This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to avoid a termination of service and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
