

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH KING PAVING AND ROTH ENTERPRISES FOR GRADING AND PAVING OF APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET WESTERLY FROM BRECKSVILLE ROAD ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, King Paving Company and Roth Enterprises are in the process of improving an existing dedicated right-of-way; the cost of the improvement will be paid by Bay Metals; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director and Village Engineer have contemplated repairs to a Village-owned road nearby approximately 300 feet westerly from Brecksville Road, which repairs were to be constructed during the 1993 building season; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has estimated that costs for repair to the village road approximate \$62,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has received quotes from King Paving Company in the amount of \$38,700.00 for paving and from Roth Enterprises in the amount of \$7,000.00 for finish grade and seed work which he believes is fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to hire King Paving Company for paving and Roth Enterprises for grading, finish grade and seed work in an amount estimated not to exceed \$46,000.00 to provide emergency repairs to a Village-owned street approximately 300 feet westerly from Brecksville Road on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertising.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to complete the construction before the winter season to take advantage of savings to the taxpayers; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of

Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
