

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 2008 FORD RANGER PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OBSOLETE, AND UNFIT FOR THE USE IT WAS ACQUIRED AND THUS SURPLUS PROPERTY THAT SHOULD BE DISPOSED OF VIA TRADE-IN WITH MONTROSE FORD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service recommends that Council declare a 2008 Ford Ranger, VIN # 1FTZR45E98PA94858, personal property no longer needed public use, obsolete, and unfit for the use that it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Finance Director intend to enter into a contract with Montrose Ford for the purchase of a 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck, VIN # 1FTER1FH0NLD24974, under terms pursuant to the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Service Cooperative Purchasing Program for \$26,386.07; and

WHEREAS, Council determines that it is in the best interest of the Village to authorize disposition of the 2008 Ford Ranger via trade-in with Montrose Ford to defray the cost of the 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck; and

WHEREAS, the trade-in value is \$2,000 resulting in a total purchase price for the 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck of \$24,386.07.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Upon the recommendation of the Director of Public Service, Council declares the 2008 Ford Ranger personal property no longer needed for public use, obsolete, and unfit for the purpose for the use for which it was required and thus surplus personal property.

SECTION 2. Council authorizes the Mayor and Director of Finance to dispose of the 2008 Ford Ranger via trade-in with Montrose Ford and to credit the value of the trade-in (\$2,000) toward the purchase price of the 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck and further authorizes the Mayor and Director of Finance to execute all necessary documents to purchase the 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck under terms pursuant to the State of Ohio's Department of Administrative Service Cooperative Purchasing Program for a price not to exceed \$24,386.07.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village

of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can expeditiously trade-in the 2008 Ford Ranger to credit the toward the price of the 2022 Ford Ranger pickup truck; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
