

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. AND ANGELO BENEDETTI, INC. FOR THE 2022 ASPHALT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 14-2022 on March 29, 2022 authorizing the Director of Public Service to advertise and solicit bids for the 2022 Asphalt Program in accordance with the specifications prepared by the Village Engineer, which included both traditional and recycling paving specifications; and

WHEREAS, bids were received for the 2022 Asphalt Program and opened on May 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service recommends acceptance of the base bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., in the amount of \$684,964.42 as being the lowest and best bid for the 2022 Asphalt Program using traditional paving methods; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service recommends acceptance of the base bid of Angelo Benedetti, Inc., for \$735,178.30 as being the lowest and best bid for the 2022 Asphalt Program using recycling paving method.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Council accepts the base bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., located at 525 Dan Street, Akron, Ohio 44310, for \$684,964.42 for the 2022 Asphalt Program using traditional paving methods.
- SECTION 2. Council accepts the base bid of Angelo Benedetti, Inc., located at 94 First Avenue. Cleveland, Ohio 44146, for \$735,178.30 for the 2022 Asphalt Program using recycling paving methods.
- SECTION 3. Council authorizes the Mayor and Finance Director to execute contracts with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc., and Angelo Benedetti, Inc. in accordance with each company's respective bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to each respective contract.
- SECTION 4. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further

reason that it is immediately necessary in order to authorize the 2022 Asphalt Road Repaving Program; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


