WHEREAS, the current Agreement for Refuse Collection Services will expire on November 30, 1991 and

WHEREAS, there exists a need and desire to provide continuous collection service.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for refuse collection services.


SECTION 2: The specifications for such services now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service are hereby approved.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety to provide continuous refuse collection service provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.


