
Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- Section 1: Schedule of Positions, Salary Rates, and Wages:
The schedule of positions and compensation, bearing a date of March 27, 1989 through March 25, 1990, attached hereto and made a part hereof and the pay periods for officers, employees, and members of Boards and Commissions shall be in accordance therewith from and after March 27, 1989.
- Section 2: Ordinance No. 21-1988 and all other ordinances or parts or sections or schedules thereto which are not consistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide compensation for Village employees and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

A Part-time Police Officer on probationary status will be eligible to receive an initial uniform allowance not to exceed \$300.00. After successful completion of the probationary period, a part-time police officer will receive a supplemental uniform allowance not to exceed \$300.00. A part-time police officer will qualify for the annual uniform allowance of \$250.00 in the Calendar year following his/her first year of service to the Village.
