

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REINBOLT, EVANS & MANN, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF ARCHITECT'S SERVICE FOR AN ADDITION TO THE SERVICE BUILDING AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$4,800.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the providing of services by an architect is for personal services of a specialized nature which require the exercise of a peculiar skill and aptitude and,

Whereas, such services do not require procedures with respect to competititve bidding,

Now Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- Section 1: Council finds and determines that competitive bidding is not required for the hiring of architect services.
- Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Reinbolt, Evans & Mann, Inc., architects, for the provision of architect services in connection with an addition for cold storage to the Service Building.
- Section 3: The services to be rendered by the architect include preliminary study and drawings, working drawing and specifications, advertisement for bids and construction inspection and coordination.
- Section 4: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to draw on and pay from the proper account of the Village a sum not to exceed \$4,800.00 as payment for such services upon satisfactory evidence of the providing of service.
- Section 5: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to take advantage of the 1989 construction season and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
