

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING THE COOPERATION OF AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY TO ADD BRECKSVILLE ROAD/STREETSBORO ROAD SIGNALIZATION TO THE AMATS TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

An emergency ordinance enacted by the Village of Richfield County, Ohio, in the matter of the hereinafter described highway improvement and to request cooperation by the Policy Committee of the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study.

WHEREAS, the ~~XXXX~~ Village has identified the need for and proposes the improvement of a portion of the public highway which is described as follows:

PROJECT TERMINI AND LOCATION: Brecksville Rd./Streetsboro Rd. Inter.

PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Replace signal

said portion of public highway within the municipal corporation limits being hereinafter referred to as the highway improvement project, and,

WHEREAS, the Village estimates the total improvement project cost to be \$ 70,000, and,

WHEREAS, the Village commits to fund 100% of the preliminary engineering costs for this improvement within CY 1990, and,

WHEREAS, the Village commits to fund the local share of right-of-way acquisition, currently scheduled for CY 1991, and construction costs, currently scheduled for CY 1992, and,

WHEREAS, these costs may be paid from the following funding sources: Capital Improvement Fund, and,

WHEREAS, the AMATS Policy Committee has given preliminary approval to programming of this project, subject to passage of this legislation.

NOW THEREFORE BE it ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION I

That the Village of Richfield hereby requests the addition of the above described highway improvement project to the AMATS Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), to be funded, in part, from Federal-Aid Urban System (FAUS) funds and/or Federal Aid Minimum Allocation (FAMA) funds.

SECTION II

That the Village of Richfield commits to continual progress toward implementation of this highway improvement project, and agrees that lack of substantive progress may cause this highway improvement project to be removed from the Transportation Improvement Program by the AMATS Policy Committee.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
