

A RESOLUTION TO CONGRATULATE ST. VICTOR PARISH ON THE TWENTY-FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MISSION OF ST. VICTOR ON JUNE 4, 1964.

WHEREAS: The late Archbishop Edward F. Hoban signed a Canonical Decree on June 4, 1964 erecting the Mission of St. Victor to minister to the spiritual needs of the residents in Richfield and Bath Townships, and

WHEREAS: The Reverend Father Anthony S. Gawlik was appointed as Administrator of St. Victor Mission and assumed his duties on June 11, 1964, and

WHEREAS: On September 20, 1964 the Sisters of Charity of St. Augustine accepted the Apostolic Duty of Teaching the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine Classes for the Mission of St. Victor, and

WHEREAS: The most Reverend Clarence G. Issemann granted parish status to the Mission of St. Victor on March 1, 1965, and

WHEREAS: Sister Peter was appointed the Religious Education Coordinator for the Parish of St. Victor in August of 1973, and

WHEREAS: The Reverend Arthur A. Bacher was appointed Pastor of St. Victor Parish in 1986 and continues to serve the parish in that capacity today.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield join in their congratulations to the Parish of St. Victor and appreciation to the individuals that contributed in many significant ways to the success of the Mission of St. Victor and the Parish of St. Victor.

SECTION 2. The entire community of Richfield Village joins the Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield in expressing our gratitude to the Parish of St. Victor for administering to the spiritual needs of our residents for the past twenty-five years.

SECTION 3. Our community, each in his individual manner, joins in the celebration of the Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, June 25, 1989 at 11:30 A.M., with the most Reverend Anthony M. Pilla, Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland.


SECTION 4. This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide a timely written memorial of service and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
